## BRANCH INFORMATION

The County Donegal Branch of the Liverpool Supporters Club was founded in September 1993 and has been affiliated to the Official Liverpool Supporters Club (previously known as the LFC International Supporters Club) since then. Regular branch meetings are held in Letterkenny (Ramada Hotel), Dunkineely (Mac's Bar) in Buncrana (An Tuath Nua). Discussions will take place on up and coming trips, ticket availability and any other branch activities. All members are welcome to attend any of our meetings and application forms are available at all meetings for anyone that wishes to join the branch.

The branch was founded to serve the needs of Liverpool supporters from all over County Donegal and to bring them together in support of the Reds, which is why we have meetings in different parts of the county. Ticketing is only one aspect of what we do and we also hold other events during the season. We are one of the biggest branches in Ireland, with 274 members registered during the 2008/2009 season (South West 23, Finn Valley 21, Gweedore 6, Inishowen 28, Letterkenny 109, North East 37, Others 10). The benefits of membership include access to trips, match tickets, branch information and various functions/events. As well as branch membership, our members are also welcome to apply for membership of the Official Liverpool Supporters Club which costs around £30 and provides access to the LFC ticket exchange scheme, as well as other benefits such as a DVD and 10% discount for LFC merchandise.

### OFFICIAL TRIP AND MATCH TICKET INFORMATION

The branch organise several trips to Anfield each season and all of our members are welcome to travel. The committee will endeavour to ensure trips are as cost effective as possible for our members and will research the market to ensure they are distinctly cheaper than travel agents. Our trips usually include a 2 night stay in a quality city centre hotel, return flights from Belfast or Derry and all coach transfers to/from both airports.

Many members can avail of cheaper options if they stay less than 2 nights and arrange their own travel and apply for tickets from the branch. We are not guaranteed tickets for every game, but have had a lot of success in recent seasons, having received tickets for each home game that was played last season. We also received tickets for the 2005 Carling Cup Final, 2006 FA Cup Final and the Champions League Finals of 2005 and 2007. Last season, over 90% of all ticket requests from members were successful. Full details of tickets received are listed on our website.

### LFC FAN CARD

Each OLSC member will receive a free fan card with their OLSC membership, which will provide members with their own identity within the ticket office and will also provide a record of all games previously attended (necessary for determining ticket eligibility for the bigger games). Fan Card holders can purchase tickets online from [www.liverpoolfc.tv](http://www.liverpoolfc.tv) and also check the history of games attended. Many of our members have their own cards and we would recommend that anyone that intends to travel to Anfield regularly to apply for their own fan card.



The LFC Fan Card is required to purchase match tickets and the branch currently hold their own fan card so that we can still acquire tickets for branch members who do not possess a fan card.

Non OLSC members could also purchase a fan card up for around £3 until 31<sup>st</sup> May 2008, but a new scheme was launched on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2008 which will eventually replace the fan card with the LFC Members Card.

Cup matches and priority league games (e.g. Everton/Man. Utd) are usually subject to having attended previous fixtures that are specified by the ticket office, and this provides the information necessary to process ticket applications. It is highly recommended that frequent travellers to Anfield acquire their own fan card so that they do not miss out on tickets for the more important games.

### PTS MEMBERSHIP

A Priority Ticket Scheme (PTS) is also available from the OLSC, which provides members with access to 5,000 tickets for each home league game. The scheme is restricted to a maximum of 10,000 members and there is currently a waiting list to join. Tickets can be purchased from the LFC credit card line or from [www.liverpoolfc.tv](http://www.liverpoolfc.tv). PTS membership costs £55 per season.
